


## Thank you for your interest in The Global College!



The Global College's application is an online process. You can complete it at your own pace, logging in and out as many times as you wish.

The application consists of **six steps**, which must be completed in order. However, to allow you to advance some parts of the application, we explain below the documents that will be required.

 **Step 1:** Indicate both yours and your child's **personal details**.

 **Step 2:** Transcripts & Languages. Submit the **two most recent transcripts** you have available (at least one must correspond to a full academic year). Candidates who are not native speakers or have not studied in an English speaking school will also have to submit an **English language certificate** to accredit their fluency: TOEFL: minimum 90, 100 points recommended; IELTS: minimum 7 points; Cambridge: CAE (with marks A, B and in some cases C with a strong oral conversation) or CPE; Duolingo English Test: minimum 115 points, 120 or higher recommended.

 **Step 3** is your child's time to shine. As part of our holistic approach, we ask all candidates to submit:


→ A 200-500 word **essay**, choosing one of the following four topics

- What is something about which you have changed your mind in the last three years?
- What's a career that doesn't exist yet that you think will exist in the future? Would you want the job?
- What has been the most influential technology for you and why?
- You have been appointed Education Minister in your country. What changes would you introduce into the high school education system? What subjects/activities would you make mandatory, and which one would you cancel?

→ Information on **extra-curricular activities and achievements as well as any relevant international experiences they've had**.

→ A short **video presentation** (45 to 90 seconds) which allows us to put a face to the application and gives your child a chance to tell us more about their motivations and passions. We welcome them to share with us anything they consider relevant and have not had a chance to indicate in their application.

 **Step 4:** Submit a **Letter of Recommendation** for your child, written by one of their teachers (present or former), a coach, trainer, or mentor (relatives and family friends cannot provide references). We provide a **template** for the letter, but other formats are accepted. The letter of recommendation can be presented in English, French or Spanish.

 **Step 5** consists of the payment of the **application fee**. Upon payment, you're then put straight into **Step 6**, which means that your **application is submitted** and will be reviewed by the Admissions Team over the coming days! You can expect to receive an update within a week from submission.

### SOME ADVICE:

When you log in to your application, if any technical issues occur, try using a different browser (we recommend **Chrome**). If the problem persists, reach out to our Admissions team for assistance.

The online application does not allow you to advance to the next step without having completed the previous one (although it does allow you to go back). To avoid getting stuck at a step - if you are still waiting for the letter of recommendation or the essay for instance - you can upload a provisional blank document in the corresponding section so that you can move on to the next step of the application. However, before submitting the application, make sure you have uploaded the final documents!
